Executive Summary:

The Board of Adjustment is made up of seven citizens, and holds hearings on requests for variances and appeals of decisions by the Planning Director and Zoning Administrator. The Board does not have the authority to change zoning law. There are currently two vacant seats available on the Board; there are an additional four expired terms. It is important to fill vacancies on boards and commissions quickly so as to allow them to continue meeting on a regular basis.
