Subject: Report on property located at 1726 Kutch Drive, Flagstaff, AZ

On Thursday August 22, 2013 at approximately 1430 I met Mike Scheu, Manager of the Building Department for the City of Flagstaff at 1726 Kutch Drive, Flagstaff, AZ to do an inspection of the property for evidence of rodent harborage. The front area of the property was found to be completely over grown and would provide excellent harborage for rodents. At the west side of the property behind a locked fence we found a large pile of fire wood which would also provide excellent rodent harborage. Finally, at the east side of the property we found a storage shed which was in very bad repair, and which would also provide harborage for rodents. It is my professional opinion that the areas in question should be cleaned up to prevent the possibility of rodent infestations, especially deer mice, which are the vectors of hantavirus.
