RE: LIQUOR LICENSE APPLICATION – SERIES 12- FOR “New Jersey Pizza”

On June 27, 2014, I initiated an investigation into an application for a series 12 (restaurant) liquor license filed by Danny Thomas (Agent) on behalf of the owners New Jersey Pizza, Marco Agostini and Jamin Mareck-Loftus. Marco Agostini and Jamin Mareck-Loftus are also listed on the application. New Jersey Pizza is located at 110 S. San Francisco #C. This is an application for the new series 12 license #12033362.

I conducted a query through local systems and public access on Marco Agostini and Jamin Mareck-Loftus. I found Marco had been arrested in 2008 for failing to appear on a collection hearing. Marco was also arrested in 2012 for disorderly conduct. Marco plead guilty to the charge and entered a deferred prosecution program which resulted in the in the charges being dropped. Jamin was found to have been arrested in 2008 for carrying a concealed weapon (knife) the charge was later dismissed. I spoke with Danny Thomas who stated he is the agent on the license for administrative purposes only and Marco Agostini and Jamin Mareck-Loftus the owners would be operating the day to day operations. Marco Agostini and Jamin Mareck-Loftus have not taken the mandatory liquor law training course but planned to prior to the issuance of the license. No liquor law violations could be located for Marco Agostini and Jamin Mareck-Loftus as this will be their first liquor license.

As a result of this investigation, I can find no reason to oppose this series 12 liquor license application. Recommendation to Council would be for approval.
