

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-16

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF 2016 ANALYSIS OF IMPEDIMENTS TO FAIR HOUSING CHOICE AND AUTHORIZING ITS SUBMISSION TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT.

WHEREAS, the Flagstaff City Council is committed to meeting the national objective of the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to: (1) benefit low and moderate income persons; (2) address slum and blight; or (3) meet an urgent community need; and

WHEREAS, the City of Flagstaff recognizes and values the efforts of those who seek to reduce barriers to full and fair housing opportunity; and

WHEREAS, shelter is a basic human need and when shelter is denied, the quality of human life is greatly diminished; and

WHEREAS, people must not be denied equal access to, and enjoyment of, housing because of race, color, national origin, religion, sex, disability or familial status; and

WHEREAS, the City of Flagstaff has been designated as a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Entitlement Community by HUD; and

WHEREAS, preparation of the Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice is a federal requirement in order for local Entitlement jurisdictions to continue to receive CDBG and other HUD grant funding; and

WHEREAS, the City of Flagstaff has prepared the Analysis of Impediment to Fair Housing Choice in order to meet the federal requirement; and

WHEREAS, the Flagstaff City Council has reviewed the Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLAGSTAFF AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the 2016 Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice reflecting strategies developed within the public planning process is hereby approved and submission to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development is authorized.
